	<p>Local Rules: see framework announcement Supplementary rules to the framework announcement will be announced by the competition manager at the briefing. In principle, only the launch manager, the pilot and his mandatory helper are allowed to be in front of the safety fence. Helmets are compulsory at the starting point. Sturdy shoes must be worn. Fail-save must be available on all models and programmed to "engine off". Further details are regulated by the launch manager.</p>
Antidoping-Assignment:	<p>Antidoping-assignments of the DAeC and the anti-doping rules and standards of the national anti-doping agency (NADA) are applied. http://www.nada-bonn.de</p>
Titles and awards:	<p>The task of these competitions is the performance comparison of the German and international model aviation sport in the category long-distance flight, class F3Speed A-H and the determination of the German champion. The three best pilots will receive medals in gold, silver or bronze, each participant will receive a certificate.</p>
Conditions of participation:	<p>A participant is considered a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he or she reaches the age of 18. For further conditions, see the framework announcement.</p>
Frequencies:	<p>2,4 GHz The participants have to hold a compliant declaration for their radio; it must be shown at the registration on demand. Other frequencies on request.</p>
Registration:	<p>Registrations are open until May 30, 2022, 23:59 hrs. via the registration form at the following link: https://mq-airports.eu/competition-registration/F3Speed</p>
	<p>The re-registration deadline is June 30, 2022, as only classes will take place in which at least 5 starters are registered. Therefore, you can change until the end of June to a class taking place.</p>

Entry fees: The entry fee is to be paid by bank transfer by **31. July 2022 00:00 hrs.** at the latest and, if paid in due time, shall be for each competition and subclass entered:

EUR 35,00 for seniors
EUR 20,00 for juniors

Registration is open for all advertised classes.

In addition, a **measuring system fee of EUR 5,00 per pilot** is to be paid. This is used for maintenance/servicing of the measuring system.
